### BEDDING & SLEEPING ARRANGEMENTS

This apartment sleeps 6 guest. There is one private master bedroom with a queen bed. In the living area, there is a comfortable sofa which converts to a king bed for 2 people. A double bed in the second bedroom sleeps 2 people.

### LINENS
